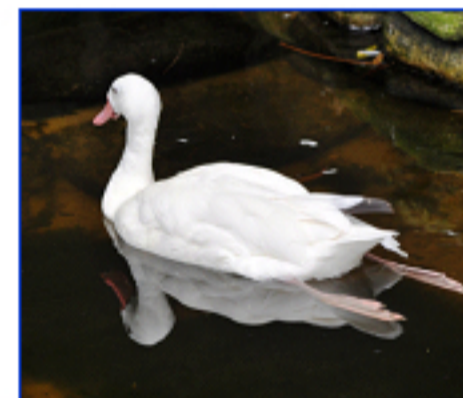
Rainforest Secrets--Rainforests are the most diverse ecosystems on our planet. Experience the wonders of the tropical rainforest with some very special zoo friends.
